



Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program Grant

St. Louis County is in receipt of American Reinvestment and Recovery Act (ARRA) funds allocated from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development under the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program (HPRP). St Louis County Older Resident Programs received funds to help people 60 and older who live in Saint Louis County to stabilize their housing situation or re-house those who have lost their housing.

Eligibility requirements:

- Person must be homeless or in imminent danger of becoming homeless
- Person must be 60 years of age or older
- Last permanent address must have been in St. Louis County
- Citizen of the United States or be able to document lawful immigrant status
- Gross income must be at or below 50% of Area Median Income (\$23,750 for one person, \$27,150 for two people)
- Person must be sustainable after grant assistance has ended. Basic income guideline for sustainability is 25% of Area Median Income (or half of the amounts above)
