

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO SIGNAGE REGULATIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Section 19A-16(a)(5) of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka is hereby repealed in its entirety and a new Section 19A-16(a)(5) is hereby enacted in lieu thereof which shall read as follows:

(5) Window signs. Shall not cover more than fifty percent (50%) of the total window area and/or glass door to which they are applied. The percentage of signage authorized under this subsection may cover any portion of the allowable area, and need not be calculated and displayed on an individual window pane or glass door basis. Such signs shall be securely affixed to the window and/or glass door. The total window area is to be determined per building side.

SECTION 2:

The provisions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect in the event the City or the third party Municipal Code codification company the City engages makes non-substantive changes to the language herein contained or section numbers herein referenced.

SECTION 3:

All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval.
