

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE DISPLAY LOT PROVISIONS**

WHEREAS, the Board has deemed it appropriate to amend motor vehicle display lot provisions to be more permissive with respect to the location of such.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Section 23-91.2(14) of the Municipal Code is hereby repealed, and a new Section 23-91.2(14) is hereby enacted which shall read as follows:

(14) No motor vehicle sales display lot may be located within one thousand (1,000) feet of another such facility, however, those not situated along the same road frontage, those which only offer a motor vehicle for sale on consignment and whose authorization limits the number of motor vehicles which may be for sale at any time to less than two (2) and those solely displaying motorcycles or public safety vehicles and related apparatus shall not be required to have such one thousand (1,000) foot separation from other motor vehicle display lots.

SECTION 2:

The provisions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect in the event the City or the third party Municipal Code codification company the City engages makes non-substantive changes to the language herein contained or section numbers herein referenced.

SECTION 3:

All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
