

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF CERTAIN MOTORIZED VEHICLES

WHEREAS, a determination has been made that it is appropriate to amend the Municipal Code to regulate the proximity with which one may operate certain motorized vehicles to another residential property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Subsection 13-73.4(c) of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka is hereby repealed in its entirety, and a new Subsection 13-73.4(c) is hereby enacted in lieu thereof which shall read as follows:

(c) It shall be unlawful to operate an all-terrain vehicle, go-cart, dune buggy, motorcycle or dirt bike on private property within one hundred (100) feet of another's residential property, unless such is being operated for property maintenance purposes.

SECTION 2:

Subsection 13-144.1(c) of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka is hereby repealed in its entirety, and a new Subsection 13-144.1(c) is hereby enacted in lieu thereof which shall read as follows:

(c) It shall be unlawful to operate a motorcycle, all-terrain vehicle, go-cart, dune buggy or dirt bike designed for use off of paved roads on private property within one hundred (100) feet of another's residential property.

SECTION 3:

The provisions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect in the event the City or the third party Municipal Code codification company the City engages makes non-substantive changes to the language herein contained or section numbers herein referenced.

SECTION 4:

All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
