ORDINANCE NO. 2387

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE HARBORING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has determined that it is appropriate to provide for the harboring of certain animals only on tracts zoned Large Lot Residential District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Section 4-1. Keeping and Harboring - Generally.

(a) No person shall keep, raise or harbor any horse, pony, cow, sheep or goat within the City unless such animals are kept on tracts zoned Large Lot Residential District not less than three (3) acres in size, with no more than one (1) of any such animal being allowed per acre.

SECTION 2:

The provisions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect in the event the City or the third party Municipal Code codification company the City engages makes non-substantive changes to the language herein contained or section numbers herein referenced.

SECTION 3:

All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval.
