

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE OPERATION OF FOOD TRUCKS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has determined that it wishes to provide for the limited operation of food trucks in certain areas of the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

A new Section 12-38(a) of the Municipal Code is hereby enacted to read as follows:

(a) Operation of Food Trucks

Food trucks may be operated in commercial districts and in subdivision common areas such as adjacent to pools, clubhouses or other recreational amenities (Board of Trustees approval is required for residential subdivision events). A commercial entity or subdivision may propose no more than three (3) such instances in a calendar year, with no more than two (2) food trucks being operated at a single event. Regardless of whether the food trucks are proposed to be operated in City right-of-way or on private property, Board of Aldermen approval through the Special Event application consideration process is required.

SECTION 2:

The provisions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect in the event the City or the third party Municipal Code codification company the City engages makes non-substantive changes to the language herein contained or section numbers herein referenced.

SECTION 3:

All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval.
