**SPECIAL NOTES:**

1. Property owners and hunters must abide by the City of Eureka Deer Control Policy and Hunting Regulations as stated in Ordinance No. 2503, a PDF of which is posted on the City's website, or a hard copy is available at Eureka City Hall.
2. The Property owner must notify contiguous neighbors in writing prior to any hunting activity and the property owner must be able to show the appropriate documentation of receipt of the notification of the dates and time periods of the hunts.
3. Hunters shall provide a certificate of completion of an archery device hunter safety course as approved or provided by the Missouri Department of Conservation prior to hunting within the Eureka City limits.
4. Prior to the engagement of any hunting activity, the property owner shall provide to the City, a certificate of insurance or indemnity bond providing evidence of a policy of liability insurance and/or indemnity bond in an amount not less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence insuring or bonding the property owner or not less than two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) per occurrence insuring or bonding the designated non-owner hunter. The insurance or indemnity bond of the property owner and the hunter may be combined to reach the minimum limits mandated by Ordinance 2503.
5. All hunters must be at least eighteen (18) years of age to hunt deer within the City limits of Eureka.
6. The property on which the hunt shall occur is at least one (1) acre or is a combination of owner approved properties that are adjacent and total at least one (1) acre.
7. The hunter shall obtain permission of any property owner prior to engaging in a reasonable search and retrieval of deer.
8. Hunters shall notify Eureka City Hall via phone or by delivering written notification to the Building Commissioner within two (2) business days of any deer harvested.

**INDEMNITY CLAUSE AND WAIVER**

The undersigned property owner(s) and hunter(s) acknowledge and agree to abide by the terms and conditions of the City of Eureka Deer Control Policy and Hunting Regulations, as well as all State regulations concerning deer hunting. The undersigned further agree(s) to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City of Eureka, from any and all claims which may arise from hunting within the City, whether such claim is based on property damage or personal injury, or whether or not the claim is based on my actions, the actions of my agents or assigns, or if the claim arises on property other than my own, including acts of negligence, and I further agree that this indemnity clause includes the reimbursement to the City of Eureka for any and all costs of defense, including court costs and attorney fees, in the event that the City is named as a defendant.
