Present at roll call were: Chairman Knapp, Alderman Sir and members Wilton, Bieg, Barry, Scheer, Gianino and Pacino (Mr. Smith was absent). Also in attendance was City Administrator Craig Sabo.

- A. A petition initiated by the City of Eureka to amend the Municipal Code to provide for Electric Vehicle Charging Infrastructure as a Special Use.

Notice of the Public Hearing was published in the Countian on July 9, 2021 and posted on the City's website.

City Administrator Sabo stated that the City had received an inquiry about the possibility of a publicly available electric vehicle charging station at Eureka Pointe Shopping Center. He said the proposed Code amendment would establish regulations for such an operation in each zoning district classification, with a Special Use Permit always being required in commercial or industrial zoning districts (and in residential zoning districts if greater than 240 Volts).

Mr. Bieg asked for clarification regarding the required parking provisions.

City Administrator Sabo stated that with any new development the electric vehicle charging station places would be included in the minimum parking requirements, and if existing parking spaces are used, the overall off-street parking would still need to meet the minimum required number.

No one spoke in opposition to the petition.

The public hearing was closed at 7:02 p.m.
