

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PARK BOARD PROVISIONS

WHEREAS, a determination was made to increase the number of Park Board members from eleven (11) to twelve (12) and adopt other amendments in the Park Board Article to replace obsolete provisions.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Chapter 2, Article V of the Municipal Code is hereby repealed and a new Chapter 2, Article V is hereby enacted in lieu thereof which shall read as follows:

**ARTICLE V
Park Board****Section 2-85. Establishment**

There is hereby established an advisory Park Board for the City to consist of twelve (12) members.

Section 2-86. Appointment and Term of Office

The Mayor shall appoint, with the approval of the Board of Aldermen, a total of twelve (12) Park Board members, with three (3) from each of the three (3) wards and three (3) from the City at large. No such appointee shall be a member of the municipal government. Each year, the Mayor shall appoint, with the approval of the Board of Aldermen, Park Board members as required depending upon the expiration of the respective terms of office, each of whom shall hold office for three (3) years. The Park Board shall elect one (1) of their members as chairperson.

Section 2-87. Duties Generally

Duties of the Park Board may include, but are not limited to, the following:

(1) Recommend improvements for existing parks including maintenance, plantings, features equipment and amenities, (2) Advise on basic policies that guide the department such as fees, charges, grounds and facility usage and programs, (4) Review proposed or recommend new programs and events for inclusion into Parks and Recreation Department offerings, (5) Review park dedication proposals and (6) Volunteer as available to assist with the operation of park programs, activities and events.

Section 2-88. Compensation

Park Board members shall receive no compensation as such, but shall receive an expense allowance of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month upon attendance at the regular monthly Park Board meeting.

SECTION 2:

The provisions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect in the event the City or the third party Municipal Code codification company the City engages makes non-substantive changes to the language herein contained or section numbers herein referenced.

SECTION 3

All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage and approval.
