

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO UNINVITED SOLICITATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code has been previously amended to remove the option for one to request consideration to engage in door-to-door uninvited solicitations through the Special Use Permit Process; and

WHEREAS, a reference to these obsolete provisions contained in another chapter of the Municipal Code was inadvertently not repealed at the time of the subject Municipal Code amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Section 15-15 of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka, Missouri, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2:

Section 15-16 of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 15-16. Same - Uninvited Solicitations.

No person shall go upon any property for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares, merchandise or services or for the purpose of disposing of or peddling or hawking the same.

SECTION 3:

The provisions contained herein shall remain in full force and effect in the event the City or the third party Municipal Code codification company the City engages makes non-substantive changes to the language herein contained or section numbers herein referenced.

SECTION 4:

All ordinances, parts of ordinances or provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Eureka in conflict with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
